EDITORIAL

With the rapid growth of gels in the market, many nail techs have found themselves bombarded with questions regarding gel lamp technology. Traditional standard UV lamps are no longer the only or best — choice for busy nail techs. Couple that with many scare tactics about the safety of standard UV lamps, and it's your job as a nail tech to make sure you and your clients are educated and confident about the services you provide.

So let's start at the beginning.

EDITORIAL

WHAT IS UV LIGHT? All light is categorized by its different band of wavelengths. Visible light for humans occurs between 400 and 780 nanometers (nm) on the Electromagnetic Spectrum. UV (ultraviolet) light is electromagnetic radiation with a wavelength shorter than that of visible light — it occurs between 100 and 400 nm. UV operates on a broader spectrum, while LED (light-emitting diodes) operates on a narrower band of 400-410 nm.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN? Photo-initiators (used to cure gel nail products) are most effective at a specific bandwidth. Because of the different band of wavelengths, the same chemistry that photo-cures in UV may not work with LED. This is why it's extremely important to use the recommended lamp for your chosen gel product. Different photo-initiators may be needed in a specific gel to cure in a UV lamp versus an LED lamp.

WHY CHOOSE LED OVER UV? LED lamps cure gels faster. This is great for several reasons. First, your clients' hands aren't subjected to minutes-long exposure under the UV lights, reassuring them about what they "think" is potentially harmful. (It's important to remember that it's been reported by the *Journal of Investigative Dermatology* that UV lamps do not appear to significantly increase the lifetime risk of skin cancer.) Second, the faster the cure time is, the faster the service is, which is ultimately better for business.

LED lamps typically use less power than standard UV lamps, they're lighter in weight, and one of the coolest selling points — the bulbs last up to 50,000 hours, so you'll never have to replace a bulb again. (Remember with standard UV lamps, you get far fewer hours of functional use out of the bulbs, which normally need to be replaced every two to four months depending on the amount of use.)

It is specially designed for rapid and efficient gel curing, particularly for the high-performance Gelish Soak-Off Gel Polishes. IN**THE**SPOTLIGHT

First Look

Gelish U.S. Dean of Education MaeLing Parrish utilized her background in art to establish herself as one of the top nail educators in the U.S. Find out what makes her tick in the one-on-one interview below.

What is your favorite nail art to do and why? My favorite will always be 3-D acrylic flowers. I love creating super-thin multi-layered flowers.

Tell us about your first educator training where you were the trainee: To preface this story, a "jelly-bean" nail looks like a jelly bean cut in half length-wise and stuck on top of the nail. It's pretty much a wide, fat, humped nail.

When I attended my first educator training, I didn't know what to expect because I was only familiar with "salon-style" sculptured nails and not "professionalstyle" sculptured nails. I was asked to apply a pink-andwhite sculptured acrylic on our practice partner, which I thought I did a pretty darn good job on. Gari-Dawn Tingler, who was the dean of education at the time, took one look at it and sarcastically said, "Nice jelly bean," and walked away. As my eyes filled with tears, my partner said to me, "Don't cry!" I thought to myself: "Really? Like telling me not to cry is going to stop the tears from coming!" Gari-Dawn and the director of education for the distributor looked over and saw my distress. The director explained to Gari-Dawn that I had never seen or performed this style of nail before. She walked back over to me, looks at my nail again and said, "Oh...that looked pretty good." Ever since then, we always have a good laugh when that story gets brought up!

What is your favorite Gelish color and/or collection?

My favorite is the Gelish Aurora Collection. I have a fetish with my toes and I like to create a teal-mermaid design, which I always layer with one of the colors from the Gelish Aurora collection.

How is your job fulfilling? My job as a nail tech is very fulfilling because it led me to be an educator. I never

knew that I wanted to be an educator for a nail company – I actually fell into it by accident. It lets me help other technicians hone their skills and learn new techniques. I love that one moment when a student gets it and the light bulb goes off in her head.

Tell us a little about yourself. Hove Hello Kitty! I just saw an ad in a nail magazine and the whole nail salon is decked out in Hello Kitty. I'm also a foodie. Hove to hang out with my girlfriends over a good dinner and have a couple of cocktails. My favorite color is white. It's just clean – a clean slate...you can do anything with white. And Hove movies – I can see the same movie five times in a row. Hove to throw out movie lines all day long and I make my friends guess the movie lines. My favorite movie is "Pride and Prejudice" — the version with Keira Knightley. Hove Mr. Darcy!

Who's the most inspirational person you've met and what makes him/her inspiring? The most inspirational person I've ever met in the industry is Tom Holcomb, who passed away recently. He was one of those people who could help anyone in the room. It didn't matter if you

who could help anyone in the room. It didn't matter if you were a beginner nail tech or advanced nail tech – he was just uplifting. His ideas...I don't know where they came from. He would think of things that nobody has ever thought of. He really changed how people think about nail art. Up until Tom Holcomb, there really wasn't nail art like he did – the 3-D nail art that included crazy designs that rose four inches above the nails. He replicated the New York skyline on a set of nails and it was so exact;

with windows and everything. Besides that, he was an all-around great person to be around. There was no "Debbie downer" with Tom; everything → was always happy and fun. He will be greatly missed.

Watch the step by step



01

Shape the nail using a 240/240 Thin Wooden File. Push back the cuticle and remove any non-living tissue from the nail plate. Remove the shine from the nail plate using the 180-grit side of the Harmony 100/180 grit buffer. Apply Nail Surface Cleanse to a lint-free nail wipe to remove any dust. Apply pH Bond to remove any excess moisture from the nail plate.



02

Apply a very thin coat of Foundation Base Gel to the entire nail. Cap the free edge. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 5 seconds (or 1 minute in a 36-watt UV Light). Using a clean dry gel brush, wipe the surface of the cured Foundation Gel to remove excess tackiness.



03

Apply a thin coat of My Nightly Craving to the entire nail. Cap the free edge. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 30 seconds (or 2 minutes in a 36 watt UV Light). Apply a second coat of My Nightly Craving to the entire nail. Cap the free edge. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 30 seconds (or 2 minutes in a 36-watt UV Light).



04

Using a small piece of makeup sponge and Tweezers, dab Love Me Like a Vamp onto the nail to achieve a frame effect. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 30 seconds (or 2 minutes in a 36-watt UV Light). Apply a coat of Top It Off to the entire nail. DO NOT CURE.



05

Place your lace design onto the nail in the desired location using Tweezers. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 30 seconds (or 2 minutes in a 36 watt UV Light). Apply a coat of Top It Off to the entire nail. Cap the free edge. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 30 seconds (or 2 minutes in a 36-watt UV Light). Using a clean #6 square gel brush, wipe off excess product from the nail.



06

FOUNDATION

With the extra fine end of a marbleizing tool and Black Shadow, add extra dots to emphasize the designs on the nail. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 30 seconds (or 2 minutes in a 36-watt UV Light).



07

Apply a coat of Top It Off to the entire nail. Cap the free edge. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 30 seconds (or 2 minutes in a 36-watt UV Light). Apply Nail Surface Cleanse to a lint-free nail wipe to remove the tacky surface.

Shape the nail using a 240/240 Thin Wooden File. Push back the cuticle and remove any non-living tissue from the nail plate. Remove the shine from the nail plate using the 180-grit side of the Harmony 100/180 grit buffer. Apply Nail Surface Cleanse to a lint-free nail wipe to remove any dust. Apply pH Bond to remove any excess moisture from the nail plate. Apply a very thin coat of Foundation Base Gel to the entire nail. Cap the free edge. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 5 seconds (or 1 minute in a 36-watt UV Light). Using a clean dry gel brush, wipe the surface of the cured Foundation Gel to remove excess tackiness.





Apply a thin coat of My Nightly Craving to the entire nail. Cap the free edge. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 30 seconds (or 2 minutes in a 36-watt UV Light). Apply a second coat of My Nightly Craving to the entire nail. Cap the free edge. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 30 seconds (or 2 minutes in a 36-watt UV Light).



03

Apply a drop of A Touch of Sass and Black Shadow to the nail plate. Using a small piece of makeup sponge and Tweezers, dab A Touch of Sass onto the nail to achieve a gradient effect from the top of the nail to the middle, at an angle. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 30 seconds (or 2 minutes in a 36 watt UV Light).



04

Using a marbleizing tool and Black Shadow create a lace flower on the nail. DO NOT CURE. Using a gel striper brush and Black Shadow, add lace detail to the nail. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 30 seconds (or 2 minutes in a 36-watt UV Light).



05

Add more detail to the lace design using a gel striper brush until your desired look is achieved. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 30 seconds (or 2 minutes in a 36-watt UV Light). Accent the lace design with Meet the King by applying highlights to the lace rose and design. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 30 seconds (or 2 minutes in a 36-watt UV Light).



06

Apply a coat of Top It Off to the entire nail. Cap the free edge. Cure in the Gelish 18G LED Light for 30 seconds (or 2 minutes in a 36-watt UV Light). Apply Nail Surface Cleanse to a lint-free nail wipe to remove the tacky surface. Massage Gelish Nourish Cuticle Oil into surrounding skin.
